## Student Parking Pass Information 2020-2021

All Students need to purchase a parking pass to drive to school and park on our campus. Parking passes cost \$25.

Please be sure to allow at least one full school day to process your request. Do not wait until the last minute! Students currently driving may park on campus without a pass-through Friday 8/14/20. On Monday 8/17/20, all vehicles must have a parking pass displayed in their vehicle. Do not wait until Friday to complete the required steps because it is likely you will not get your pass in time.

You may purchase a parking pass at any time of the school year by completing the information included here. However, you are not permitted to park on campus without a parking tag displayed in your vehicle. There are no discounts or pro-rating to the fee of \$25 if purchased later in the school year.

In order to receive your parking pass, you will need to complete the following items:

1. You must be logged onto the McKeel Academy website and complete the Student Parking Pass Google document found here: <https://forms.gle/xPXhVvNyZRTpMYRt7>
2. You must print and complete the Student Driver & Parking Pass Guidelines document below and turn this into the main office with your \$25 parking fee (or paid online).

Maintaining acceptable student attendance and being on time to school are important requirements for having a parking pass at McKeel.

## 2020-2021 Student Driver & Parking Pass Guidelines

Parking for seniors will be in the front of the school. Parking for underclassmen will be in the back of the school. The speed limit on campus is 5 mph. All students must receive a parking pass before parking on campus. Please be cautious and courteous driving to and from school. Traffic does get backed up so please plan your arrival accordingly. You may not break traffic laws to avoid the car traffic. We expect all students to follow the speed limit, stay in their lane, and be courteous to our neighborhood residents. We also expect students to display your parking pass on your rear-view mirror and arrive to school on time each day. When arriving to school, you are not allowed to “hang out” in your car; you must exit your car and walk to your grade level designated spot or cafeteria for breakfast. Upon dismissal, unless you are in an after-school activity, you are to go to your car and leave the campus immediately. Failure to adhere to any or all of these expectations may result in loss of driving privileges.

I understand that in doing so, any loss due to damage or theft is not the responsibility of McKeel Academy of Technology. I further understand that the rules outlined in the Code of Conduct for Polk County and McKeel Academy of Technology Student Handbook will be strictly enforced and both my child and I will be responsible for adhering to these rules. In addition, excessive tardiness to school or irresponsible driving in the parking lot or around school may result in parking privileges being revoked. It will be the responsibility of the student and parents to provide transportation if the student does not ride a McKeel Academy school bus.
