

High School Trip Agreement

I understand that participation in the Wildcat Rules trip is voluntary, that it is not required. My student, _____, will be participating in a variety of activities: touring college campuses, staying in hotels, eating at a variety of restaurants and riding on a charter bus. The nature of the trip requires that students assume responsibility for their behavior and actions. Please read the rules and expectations listed below and sign and date the bottom if you agree.

1. A student whose behavior at school has deteriorated during the school year will be removed from the trip, forfeiting any deposit or refund of payments.
2. A student involved in a serious behavior event at school or at a school-sponsored function will be withdrawn from the trip as determined by school administration.
3. Students must stay with their group/chaperones at all times, as directed by chaperones.
4. Students must stay in their rooms at night when directed by their chaperone.
5. School rules regarding alcohol, tobacco, drugs (over the counter and illegal) apply at all times.
6. Students will not allow anyone in their hotel room for any reason after chaperones have limited you to your rooms for the night.
7. During the day, students will not allow anyone in their hotel room for any reason, except chaperones and other students on the trip when allowed by chaperones. No opposite sex visits in rooms **at any time** unless a chaperone is present.
8. Students are to be courteous and respectful to everyone they encounter on the trip.
9. Students are responsible for any damage to the bus, hotel or any facilities they use as a group or individually.
10. Any violation of school rules, the above outlined rules or other extreme behavior incidents will result in the student being sent home at the expense of the parents. The student may also face additional disciplinary action and possible withdrawal from McKeel Academy. If one student is sent home, school administration has the option of canceling the trip and bringing **ALL** students home.
11. Students and/or parents will be held financially responsible for any damages incurred while on the trip.
12. Regardless of payment status of the trip, students who have earned a D or F in any class for the first semester will forfeit their right to attend. In addition, students are responsible for making up missing assignments while gone per our attendance policy.
13. Regardless of payment status of the trip, students should not have missed more than 10 days of School or be on Attendance Contract. Any incidence of skipping school or a class will result in dismissal from the trip.
14. During the trip, students will participate in all activities with a positive attitude.
15. Students must use caution when in conversation with anyone who is not part of the trip.
