## **Requirements:**

- Earned six high school credits
  - Have a 3.5 unweighted cumulative GPA
  - Cannot be enrolled in Intensive Reading
1. Complete online application and online orientation through Polk State web page ([www.polk.edu](http://www.polk.edu)). Please keep orientation certificate for your records.
  2. Take the Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (PERT). The PERT is being offered on our campus on April 25, 2018 after school. Students are also welcome to take the PERT at PSC (check web page for dates and times). The online application must be completed prior to taking the PERT at PSC.
  3. Based on PERT scores, determine which course(s) you are eligible to take and meet with your School Counselor to complete the High School Approval Form and Dual Enrollment Contract. **All forms are due Friday, May 21, 2018 to your School Counselor.**
  4. Register on our campus in August.

## **Benefits of Dual Enrollment:**

- All Dual Enrollment classes, fees, and textbooks are provided by MAT or PSC.
- Dual Enrollment students may begin their college careers at PSC depending on their qualifications and core credits earned.
- Dual Enrollment students may pursue course work towards an Associates Degree on MAT or PSC campuses.
- Each student who successfully completes a Dual Enrollment course earns high school credit while simultaneously earning college credit.
