2020-2021 Contract

In becoming a member of the McKeel Academy of Technology NHS, you assume certain responsibilities. First and foremost, students must agree to uphold the duties outlined in the NHS National Constitution. Secondly, members must adhere to the bylaws of the McKeel NHS Chapter outlined below. Failure to uphold these standards can result in probation, or even revocation of membership. The duties for which you are held responsible are the following:

1. To attend all Chapter meetings at 8:00am in the auditorium **see McKeel website for the annual schedule*
 - a. 1 hr. of extra service for first missed meeting
 - b. 2 hrs.of extra service for second missed meeting
 - c. Students will be reviewed by the Faculty Council if a third meeting is missed
 - d. *Please plan outside appointments, tutoring or retakes with teachers accordingly!*
2. To be aware of and adhere to all established deadlines for turning in required items such as contracts, dues, fundraising materials, and service hours.
3. To accumulate a minimum of 20 hours of service by participating in a combination of Chapter projects such as tutoring, fundraising, community outreach, and individual projects outside of McKeel. Hours are to be completed, documented and turned in **by Wednesday, April 28th.**

At least 5 of these hours must be ACADEMIC tutoring, either at MAT, MAC, or SMA (or another school) under the supervision of a teacher! *See tutoring guidelines on the McKeel website. **Please note that NHS hours may NOT be used towards graduation.*

4. To maintain communication with the faculty sponsor through email, face-to-face contact.
5. To participate in at least 1 NHS project! This could include fundraisers, the pancake breakfast, canned food drive, induction ceremony, teacher appreciation project, etc.
6. To maintain a 3.5 cumulative weighted GPA. Grade checks each semester
7. To maintain an untarnished character and provide a good example for the rest of the student body in all on and off campus behavior and interactions. This includes online behavior and social media; poor digital citizenship is grounds for dismissal. Members who receive a referral for cheating will be automatically dismissed. Discipline is reviewed each quarter.

I agree to fulfill the above responsibilities to maintain good standing in the McKeel National Honor Society. I understand that failure to completely fulfill these duties could result in probation or dismissal from NHS.
